DESCRIPTIONS FOR THE FINAL EXAM REPORT

1- Grade > Your current grade level

2- Group > The group you are in based on the competition conditions. Students from 3 different grade levels in each group answer the same questions.

3- Total Score > 4 points you get from each question (+)

Time bonus points for finishing the exam early (+)

Balancing bonus points based on your grade (if applicable)

Bonus Points > It is an additional point awarded to lower grades in order to provide balance in group assessment and ranking. (+20 points were added to the 1st, 4th, 7th and 10th grades, +10 points were added to the 2nd, 5th, 8th and 11th grades.)

4- Total Number of Participants in Current Grade > It is the total number of students in your grade who took the first and second exams from all countries. It does not represent the total number of finalists. This number includes those who were eliminated in the first and second qualification exams.

5- Global Grade Ranking > Your position among all students in your grade level. (It is your position among the finalists based on your final exam score.)

6- Total Number of Participants in Current Group > It is the total number of students from three grade levels in your group who took the first and second qualification exams. It does not represent the total number of finalists. This number includes those who were eliminated in the first and second qualification exams.

7- Global Group Ranking > Your position among all students in your group. (It is your position among the finalists based on your final exam score.)

FINAL RESULTS;

8- > Participation Certificates: It is the CERTIFICATE OF PARTICIPATION IN THE FINALS, which is only given to the students who take the final exam.

9- > Codementum Certificate of Completion: This certificate is only given to students who participate in the Computer Science category in final.

10- > Digital Medal Certificate: It is a digital medal certificate given according to the percentile among the students from the same grade level that competed in the final. (Not according to the total number of participants in the current grade level.)

11- > Grade Achievement Certificate: It is an achievement certificate given to students who rank in the top ten in their **grade level**. It consists of Gold, Silver, Bronze and 6 Honorable Mention certificates. The originals of the Gold, Silver and Bronze certificates are mailed to the student for free.

12- > Group Grade Achievement Certificate:

It is an achievement certificate given to students who rank in the top ten in their **group level**. It consists of Gold, Silver, Bronze and 6 Honorable Mention certificates. The originals of the Gold, Silver and Bronze certificates are mailed to the student for free.

13- > Medal / Awards (You will receive an email on 28.03.2022)

- The top 3 students in **Grade Level** will receive the following by post free of charge:

- > Original medals along with their certificates
- > STEM BOX awards

- The top 3 students in **Group Level** will receive the followings:

- > All the students will be provided with a one-year subscription to Codementum as a gift.
- > In addition, among the students in 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th and 11th grades;
 - First places: will receive a 75% discount for participation in the Grand Final.
 - Second places: will receive a 50% discount for participation in the Grand Final.
 - Third places: will receive a 25% discount for participation in the Grand Final.
